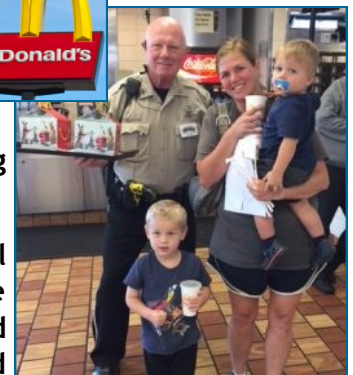


Our special guest speaker was past Sheriff of Bexar County, Susan Pamerleau.

It covers both injury and death in the line of duty for all First Responders and their agency support staff in Comal County. Death in the line of duty is covered by \$50,000. Additionally, First Responder beneficiaries will receive a \$10,000 check from The 100 Club of Comal County within

24 hours of a tragedy, providing them with funding for their immediate needs.

Future plans for The 100 Club will be to provide a scholarship program for graduating children of Comal County's First Responders.

We were deeply saddened by the death of our fellow Board Member, Eric White, on March 22 of this year. Eric served on the Board for 7 years and we will truly miss him .
