A big thank you to McDonald's Restaurants and our Comal County community for their continued support of The 100 Club of Co-

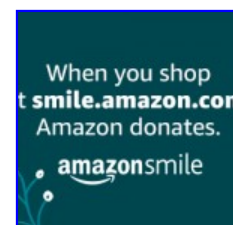
mal County. McDonald's graciously donated a portion of their proceeds from Good Friday sales and helped "support those who protect us." We love Ronald McDonald!
